



# Biskupská kupa Lookout Tower

Near Zlaté Hory, it was built as the first stone lookout tower in the Jeseník Mountains. It is 19 m high and from the lookout tower, all the peaks of the Jeseník Mountains, including Praděd, can be seen. To the west you can see Králický Sněžník and Sněžka, to the east the Beskyd Mountains and the highest peaks of the High Tatras under a very good visibility.

The vast plain of the Polish lowlands then opens to the north where you can observe Opole (65 km) and the outlines of Wrocław, 100 km away. It is open in good weather all year round.
