



# Borůvková Hora Mountain

A beautiful lookout tower in the heart of the Rychlebské hory (Rychlebské Mountains) is 25 meters high, made of metal and lined with wood (898 m above sea level). Next to the tower there is a shelter in case you get caught in bad weather. In the summer season, a snack bar is open there.

From here you can see Otmuchów and Nysa Lakes and Łądek-Zdrój on the Polish side. On the Czech side of the Rychlebské hory (Rychlebské Mountains), Šerák, Praděd, Smrk, Králický Sněžník and even the Krkonoše Mountains can be seen under excellent visibility conditions.

Tourist signs to Borůvková Hora Mountain lead from Javorník, Travná, Bílá Voda and Poland. Just choose. The easiest way is to park a car in Travná. From there, follow the blue tourist sign to the “Borůvková hora” signpost and then follow the red tourist sign to the top of the mountain to the lookout tower.
